- 1 Meet with an IU South Bend admissions representative at Plymouth High School, #1 Big Red Drive, 4-6 p.m. Tuesday, April 22. Enter high school at entrance #9. Bring a copy of your high school transcript or GED scores.
- 2 Take placement exams on Saturday, May 3, at Plymouth High School. Tests begin at 8:30 a.m.
- 3 Attend new student orientation at 8:30 a.m., Saturday, May 17 or Friday, June 20, on the main campus in South Bend. You will meet with an academic advisor and register for fall semester classes at this time.
